Abstract of claims to land in West Florida, founded on written permits of settlement given by the Spanish government, confirmed by commissioners Samuel R. Overton, Joseph M. White, Graven P. Lockett Claim by Phoebe Pyburn Turvin, original claimant, Jephtha Turvin dated claim Feb 1807, at head of Indian Creek, given by Gov. Folch - surveyed 28 May 1821 cleared and cultivated from 1801 to 1817
